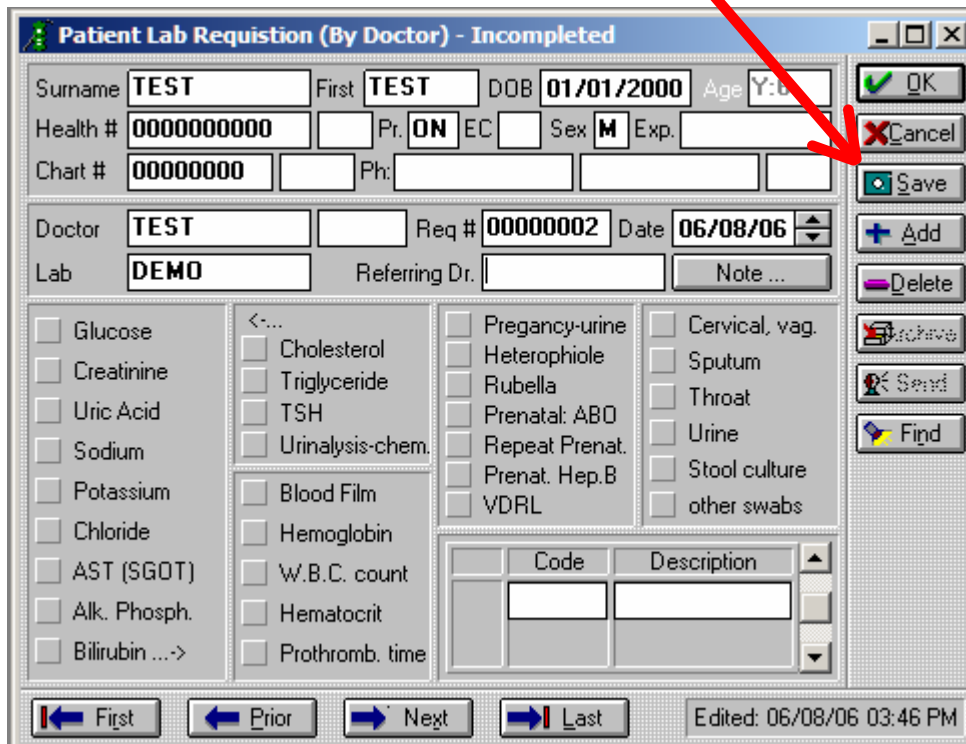


How to print a Laboratory Requisition Form?

1. Click on the [+] symbol to the right of the 'lab' icon.



2. Pull up the patient record and then click on 'Save'.
